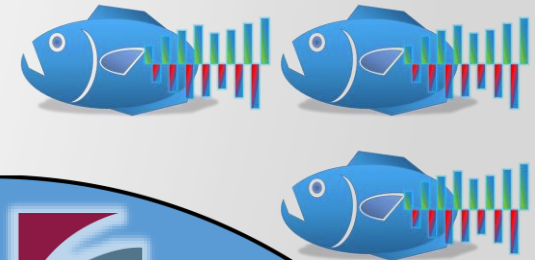

Producers spend an estimated **\$5.2 million** per year on regulatory compliance.
This breaks down to an average cost of \$105,000/farm, or \$2,000/acre.

Producers ship live fish to 3 other states on average. Some producers ship to almost 10 states.



On average producers are faced with 18 permit and license renewals per year. Some report in excess of 200 annual renewals.

Regulations account for about **26%** of farm costs

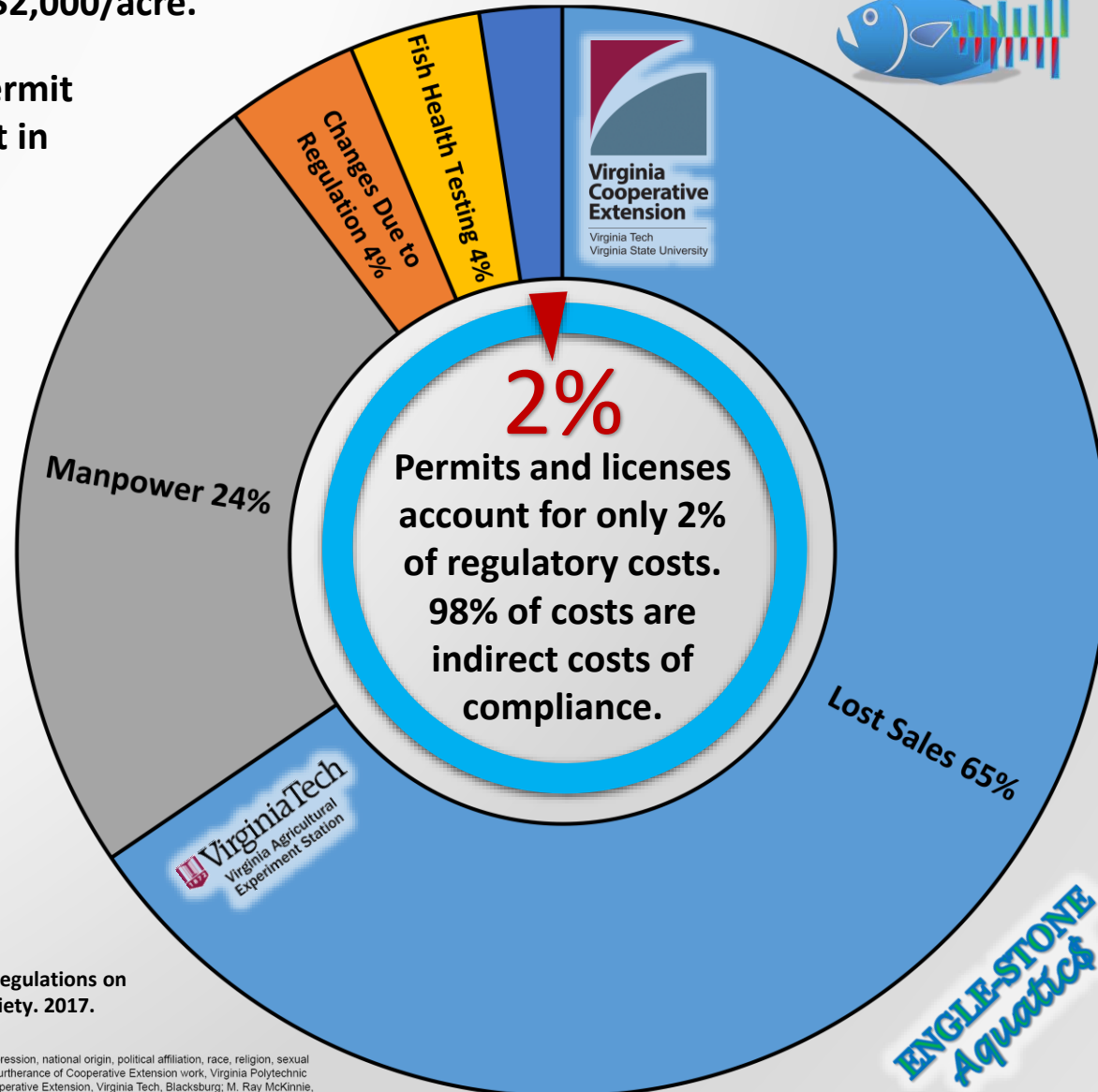
